Nominations will close at the Branch Council meeting.

Nomination forms are available from me or the branch office of the organisation. Additional forms will also be available at the meeting.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Branch's rules prior to lodging nominations.

PLEASE NOTE:

- 2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.

Withdrawing Nominations

Nominations may be withdrawn in writing up to the time determined for the printing of the ballot papers.

Voting Period

If a ballot is necessary, it will take place at the Branch Council meeting on 21/08/2018 after the closing of nominations. Any member of the Branch Council who will not be present at the meeting at which an election for Federal Delegate is to be held may, prior to the close of nominations, lodge with the Returning Officer or Branch Secretary a request for an absent vote in respect of the election, which request shall specify the address where the absent vote may be delivered.

Where it is not possible to complete the election at the relevant meeting of Branch Council because of the request for, and issue of an absent vote, the Returning Officer shall not count any votes or declare the result of the election until the member or members to whom absent votes have been issued have had such reasonable opportunity to vote as is determined by the Returning Officer.

Applications for an Absent Vote are available from the Returning Officer or the Branch office.

Scrutineers

Each candidate may appoint, in writing, one person as scrutineer to represent the candidate's interests in the conduct of the ballot. A scrutineer shall not be a candidate for any position which is also included in a ballot in the election. The candidate may appoint one or more substitute scrutineers, if required.

A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
